Minutes of the EBOD Pre-Examination Meeting Agenda, which took place in La Terrasse Eiffel in Le Méridien Etoile on Thursday 6th May 2010 from 19.00 – 22.00.

1. The minutes of the Amsterdam meeting were confirmed.
2. Discussion of confirmed running order
A document of the running order for the day was presented by Dara Conlon to all in attendance. The document was based on the running order for last year, which ultimately proved successful. After some discussion with the group, small revisions were made, to be update that night and circulated to the Executive the following morning.
3. Repartition of tasks and room allocations
The repartition of tasks was discussed with the emphasis being on exam invigilators being assigned to each exam room. The focus was on ensuring a comprehensive mix of language ability to ensure that in the event of questions in french or german, these could be answered by exam supervisors.
4. Examiner's envelope: Certificate of attendance/ID badge/personal programme

6. TTT symposium and social events.
The Executive were advised of the plans for the TTT symposium and the social events scheduled, all of which were approved as planned.
