Comprehensive clinical and surgical didactic cornea course organized as follows: basics including pathological responses of the cornea, microbiology, cytology and anatomic evaluation techniques: corneal diseases: infectious, immunologic disorders, dystrophies and degenerations and dry eye and ocular surface disease; corneal surgery: penetrating and lamellar (anterior and posterior) keratoplasty, management of postkeratoplasty astigmatism, amniotic membrane and conjunctival surgery, limbal transplantation and keratoprosthesis and collagen cross-linking techniques.

Aim(s) of the course (max. 10 lines) _____

The aim of the course is first to provide the audience a basic knowledge of the evaluation techniques used in ocular surface diseases.

The second goal is to review in a comprehensive way most of the areas of cornea and ocular surface pathology, from exogenous insults to congenital diseases.

Finally, we will extensively cover the most significant surgical techniques used nowadays in front of cornea and ocular surface diseases.
