Course synopsis (max. 10 lines)

This course will focus on ocular, conjunctival, lid and orbital tumours. The first lecture will give an overview of the different intraocular and conjunctival tumours with the clinical presentation and symptoms, pathology and main diagnostic tools. The three following lectures will include some knowledge about the management as well as case presentations and multiple choice questions of increasing difficulty. The two last talks will include didactic lectures on lid and orbital tumours, case presentations and multiple choice questions of increasing difficulty.

The goal of the course is to give the attendance some knowledge about the most frequent ophthalmic tumours with their clinical presentation and differential diagnosis with the ancillary tests and imaging tests to be performed for each of them.

Aim(s) of the course (max. 10 lines)

The aim of the course is to give an overview of the main intraocular, conjunctival, lids and orbital tumours in adults and children. The techniques useful for diagnosis and the main differential diagnosis will be reviewed.

Current management of the most frequent tumours will be described. This will include the management of uveal melanoma, retinal tumours, conjunctival, lid tumours and orbital tumours; clinical cases will be presented.

Achievements (what will the participant achieve in knowledge)

The participants should be able to recognise and diagnose ophthalmic tumours (prescribe the right imaging, use the proper biopsy technique if needed).

They should have some practical knowledge about the usual management.
