## Course synopsis (max. 10 lines)

---

The course is with 6 days the most extensive course for uveitis offered, allowing to update the participants about all important forms of intraocular inflammation and scleritis. This will include 22 lectures (duration between 30 and 120 minutes) which will cover the general and specific types of intraocular inflammation, regarding diagnostics and treatment, but also the diagnostic and management of the complications. On day 4 we will organize 4 different “Small Group Meetings”, in which case reports will be extensively discussed. These case reports are not easy to solve, but (mostly with the help of the group) a correct diagnosis and management is possible. There will be an assessment test at the first and the last day of the course.

## Aim(s) of the course (max. 10 lines)

---

The participant should learn how to organize history, diagnostics, differential diagnostics for intraocular inflammation, resulting in the development of a concept for the treatment of even complicated cases of uveitis. Previous courses have created a group atmosphere, allowing later contact to each other for information reg. complicated cases and establishment of further scientific cooperation.

**Achievements (what will the participant achieve in knowledge)** \_\_\_\_\_

During the course the participant should achieve knowledge about:

The major steps for decision making in uveitis, including planning diagnostics and adequate treatment, probably prophylaxis, what types of uveitis are known, how to differentiate them, what typical information results from good history, what are the aims of uveitis treatment, depending on the type of uveitis, how to interact adequately with uveitis patients.
