- Clinical invigilation not provided: no possibility of questions concerning the content of the exam during the exam




Format?

- Online MCQ + online clinical cases
 - 2 hours MCQ + 1 hour & 20 minutes clinical cases respectively
 - Weighting: 40% for MCQ, 60% for Clinical Cases
- English language
- Speedwell eSystem platform
- Week before exam: connection test to Speedwell eSystem and trial exam
 - Login and password sent for test
 - Familiarise yourself with technical interface
- Up to 48 hrs before exam Do the "System Test" with ProctorExam to check your set up is working
- Morning of the Exam: Log into ProctorExam system, which will direct you into Speedwell eSystem







EBO Test Exam
