When?

- Home or quiet place

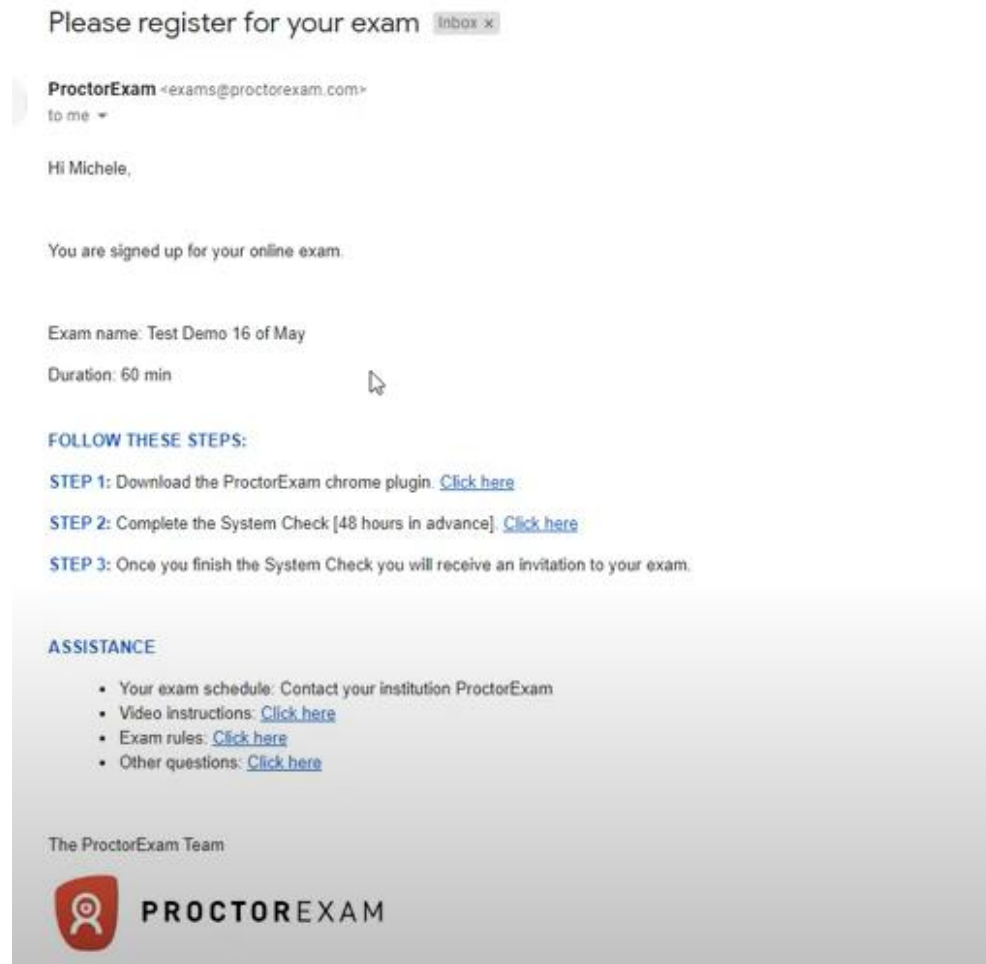
- **Alone** in the room
- **One pencil** and **empty paper** allowed

- You may **not use a second screen** for the exam

- Clinical invigilation not provided: no possibility of questions concerning the content of the exam during the exam

Format ?

- Online MCQ + online clinical cases
 - 2 hours MCQ + 1 hour clinical cases respectively
 - Weighting: 40% for MCQ, 60% for Clinical Cases
- **English** language
- Speedwell eSystem platform
- **Week before exam:** connection test to Speedwell eSystem and trial exam
 - Login and password sent for test
 - Familiarise yourself with technical interface
- **Up to 48 hrs before exam** Do the “System Test” with ProctorExam to check your set up is working
- **Morning of the Exam:** Log into ProctorExam system, which will direct you into Speedwell eSystem

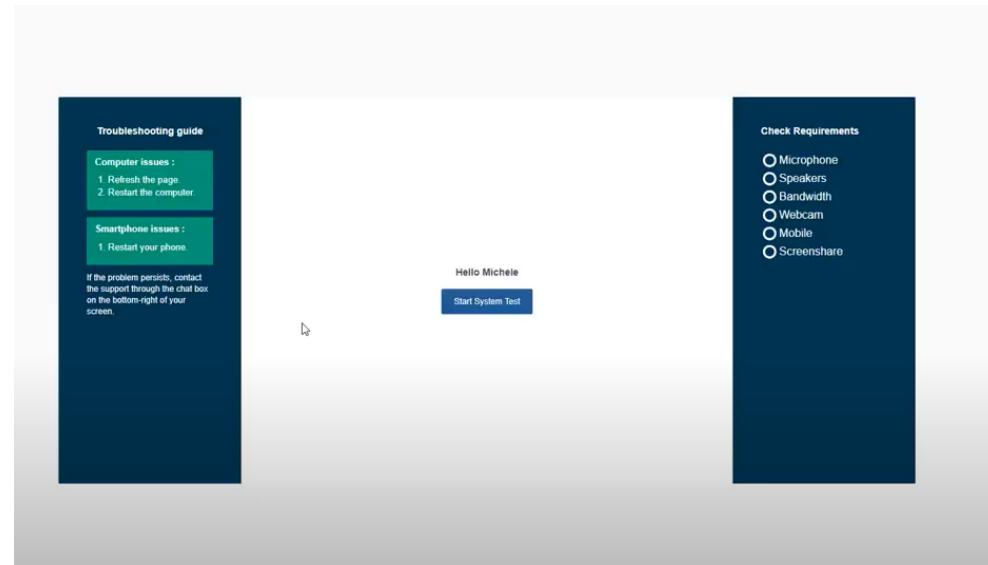

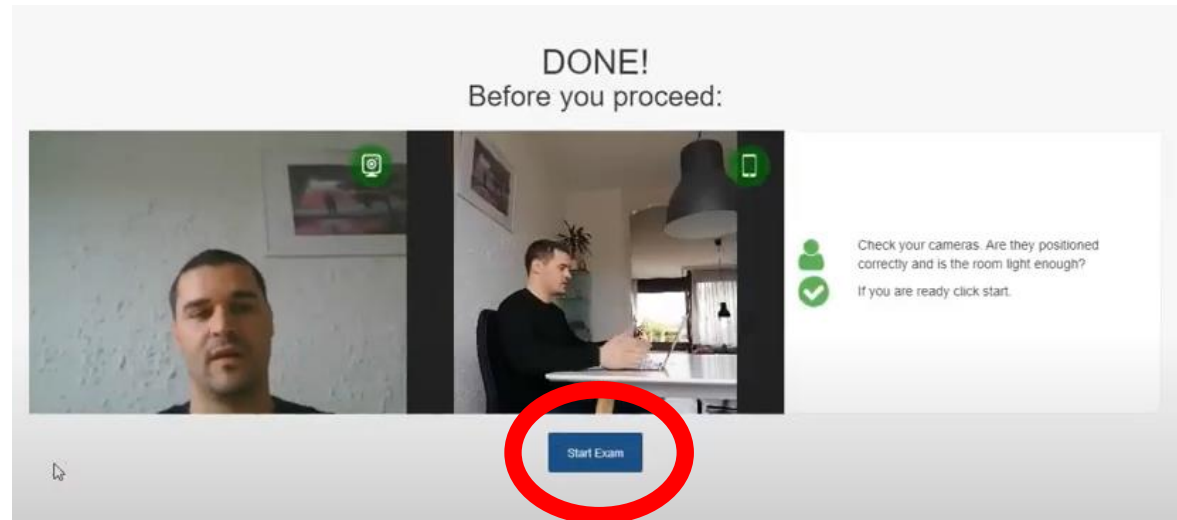

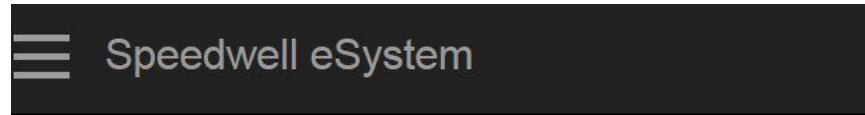
Online MCQ exam
